SUBMISSION

- 1. Two types of manuscripts could be submitted:
 - a) Research Papers (to be discussed), or
 - b) **Doctoral Research Projects** (to be discussed by an expert).
- 2. **Official languages**: extended abstract, full paper and slides can be written in Portuguese, Spanish or English. English is encouraged.
- 3. An author can present only one manuscript, but he/she can also be a non-presenting co-author on other manuscripts.

IMPORTANT KEY DATES

16th September 2018 30th September 2018 (NEW DEADLINE):

Deadline for submission the full Research Paper, the full Doctoral Research Projects or the extended abstracts of the manuscripts. Full manuscripts are encouraged.

Notification of the acceptance/rejection decision.

30th November 2018:

Deadline for the submission of the final versions (full papers), when it was submitted only the extended abstracts.

Please prepare your manuscript before submission, using the following guidelines:

Extended abstract requirements

Title	Times New Roman 14 cpi font.
	Should be supplied the full name of each author (bold font, Times New
Author details	Roman 11 cpi font), the affiliation of each contributing author and correct
	email addresses (Times New Roman 11 cpi font, italics).
Extended Abstract	Between 800 and 1000 words. Times New Roman 12 cpi font.
Keywords	Up to 5 keywords (Times New Roman 12 cpi font, italics).

Manuscript requirements

Article files should be provided in Microsoft Word format.
Research Papers should be at most 7500 words in length.
Doctoral Research Projects should be at most 5000 words in length.
This includes all text including references and appendices.
Times New Roman 14 cpi font.
Should be supplied the full name of each author (bold font, Times New
Roman 11 cpi font), the affiliation of each contributing author and correct
email addresses (Times New Roman 11 cpi font, italics).
Maximum is 10-12 lines (Times New Roman 12 cpi font).
Up to 5 key words (Times New Roman 12 cpi font, italics).
Should be numbered consecutively throughout the text with superscript
Arabic numerals, typed Times New Roman 10 cpi, and single spaced.
References to other publications must be in APA style (6th Edition) and
carefully checked for completeness, accuracy and consistency. You should
cite publications in the text: (Adams, 2006) using the first named author's
name or (Adams and Brown, 2006) citing both names of two, or (Adams et
al., 2006), when there are three or more authors. When several
publications are included consecutively, they shall be listed in chronological
order and separated by semicolon (;). If two or more publications are dated
in a same year, alphabetical order will be the second listing criteria. In case
of literal transcriptions, text shall be inside inverted commas, and reference
page/s could be included in the quoted reference, as follows: Name (year,
p. xx), (Name year, pp. xxxx). At the end of the paper a reference list in
alphabetical order should be supplied.
