About the Organization

Job Description & Qualification

The Department of Management Control and Information System (DCS) at the University of Chile (https://dcs.uchile.cl/) invites applicants for an associate professor position in the area of management control. This is a full-time position, starting on June 1st, 2021.

We are looking for applicants who can demonstrate expertise in the area of management control. The ideal candidate would hold a Ph.D. in Accounting, Management, Business, Business Administration or equivalent, and have well-rounded capabilities in teaching and research. Applicants should be able to deliver excellent teaching at both undergraduate and graduate level, and pursue their own independent research, publishing in high quality academic journals, participating in conferences, and demonstrating their ability to apply and obtain funds for research. The position in management control is particularly oriented towards strategic management.

The place to develop the job will be the Department of Management Control and Information Systems (DCS) of the Faculty of Economics and Business at the Universidad de Chile (in-person modality).

Applicants' roles and responsibilities:

- Conduct high-quality research in the area of management control.
- Contribute to existing research projects.
- Teach three courses per year at the undergraduate or graduate level. (*)
- Supervise master's level thesis work.
- Participate in administrative activities expected from Faculty.

(*) Teaching may be in English or Spanish for the first year and Spanish for the following years. Extra teaching is rewarded accordingly.

Associated salary follows the general guidelines from the University of Chile and is competitive in the local market. However, annual salary could be adjusted according to the applicant's qualifications. Additional benefits include: individual research budget renewable every year, intra-Faculty funding opportunities, and performance-based bonuses.

Selected applicants would be invited to present their work in a research seminar, followed by an interview. The results would be notified by email during May.
